- 1) Members must be in possession of full Malta regalia.
- 2) Members should be able to commit themselves to an attendance of at least 30% minimum on the list of official visits each year (family and work emergencies always excepted).
- 3) Attendance at the Meetings of;
 - a) Kent Provincial Priory each year, usually the first Saturday in July, and the preceding rehearsals.
 - b) Malta Degree Ceremonies; these are carried out annually at the February Meeting of The Kent Bodyguard Preceptory and in two other Preceptories, as notified, during the year.
 - c) The annual Provincial Church Service (a Sunday afternoon, usually in March or April).
- 4) A charge is made prior to being formally invested, currently £25, for the cost of your Mantle Badge. Each member must also meet their own costs, such as travelling, dining etc., at all Meetings attended.
- 5) Membership shall cease on the date of election as Eminent Preceptor, eight years after appointment, or at any time that may be directed by the Right Eminent Provincial Prior.
